- May 19 This afternoon we will depart for the **Drury Inn St. Louis Airport**. After checking in, enjoy the hotel's **Kickback Reception** of free hot food and cold beverages. **(Kickback Reception)**

- May 20 A continental breakfast is included at the hotel before we board the hotel's shuttle to the St. Louis airport for our flight to **Fairbanks, Alaska**. In Fairbanks we'll transfer to **Marriott's Springhill Suites** where we will check in for two nights. **(Breakfast)**

- May 22 After breakfast at the hotel we will travel to **Denali**. Upon arrival we will have lunch at the **Grande Denali Lodge**, our home for the evening. This afternoon we will depart for a **guided tour of Denali National Park**. Our expert guide will help us spot the wide variety of wildlife native to the park. **(Breakfast, Lunch)**

- May 23 Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning before we board our **dome car** for a beautiful **ride on the Alaska Railroad** from Denali to **Anchorage**. - May 27 **Skagway, Alaska** 7:00 a.m. 8:30 p.m.


- May 28 **Icy Strait Point, Alaska** 7:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m.
